Competency is gained by providing evidence of what you have been taught. You will carry out various assessments. The course has been designed to be practical based where you demonstrate your skills and knowledge through a variety of assessment procedures including, journals, short questions and answers, role play/scenarios, demonstrations and short essays.			
Support	 We offer a range of support services to ensure learners are safe and environments are conducive to learning.
